

PHONEME AND KEYWORD

/f/ as in fish

LABEL

Unvoiced fricative phoneme

GRAPHEME f

/f/ is spelled with the grapheme \underline{f} as in fish.

GRAPHEME ff

At the end of a one syllable word, /f/ is spelled with the grapheme -ff immediately after a short vowel. The red box before the grapheme -ff indicates a short vowel. This is known as part of the FLOSS rule (see /l/ and /s/ cards).

/f/ is spelled with the grapheme <u>ph</u> in words derived from the Greek language.
